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Registration & Muster Information:

Teams will be made up of a minimum of 6 Explorers, with a maximum of 10 Explorers. The Post may field more than one team: however Explorers may not move from team to team. Team members CANNOT be substituted at any time with any other persons even if that team member leaves prior to the end of the Muster. NO SUBSTITUTIONS WILL BE ALLOWED.

Team members are to be registered as “YOUTHS” with Learning for Life and NOT as “ASSOCIATE ADVISORS” and/or “ADULTS”.

ALL Explorers are REQUIRED to bring and MUST WEAR athletic shoes, and gym clothes. Helmet, gloves and safety equipment are required on certain events and are to be supplied by the team member and or his/her Explorer Post. Refer to event guidelines.

This is an “All Day” event 0800-1700 hrs and involves “Wet” events. It is suggested and recommended that team members bring a change of clothes.

Registration forms must be typed or block printed. This will ensure that the correct spelling is placed on each person’s certificate. Certificates will be distributed towards the end of the day.

If you are planning to “Dry Camp” at the Diamond Stadium, you must arrive after 2200 hrs and park in the lower overflow parking area. NO PARKING is permitted on any of the asphalt driveways or streets. Please fill in on the registration form the appropriate section for “Camping”.

On the day of the Muster, July 30, 2005, you may arrive at the Diamond Stadium as early as 0700 hrs. Please be ready to check in no later than 0715hrs.

The Muster Events start at 0800 hrs. LATE CHECK-IN’S WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

At the end of the Muster Events, and prior to the awards ceremony, All Posts are required to clean up the event grounds and their general area where they have “based” themselves for the day. Additionally, all Muster equipment will need to be broken down and put back into the vehicles to make ready for transportation back to County Posts. These tasks should only take about 15 to 20 minutes if all hands pitch in. It is the responsibility of the Post Advisor to manage their Post members throughout the day and to get all tasks done. Your diligence will insure a quick transition into the awards ceremony.

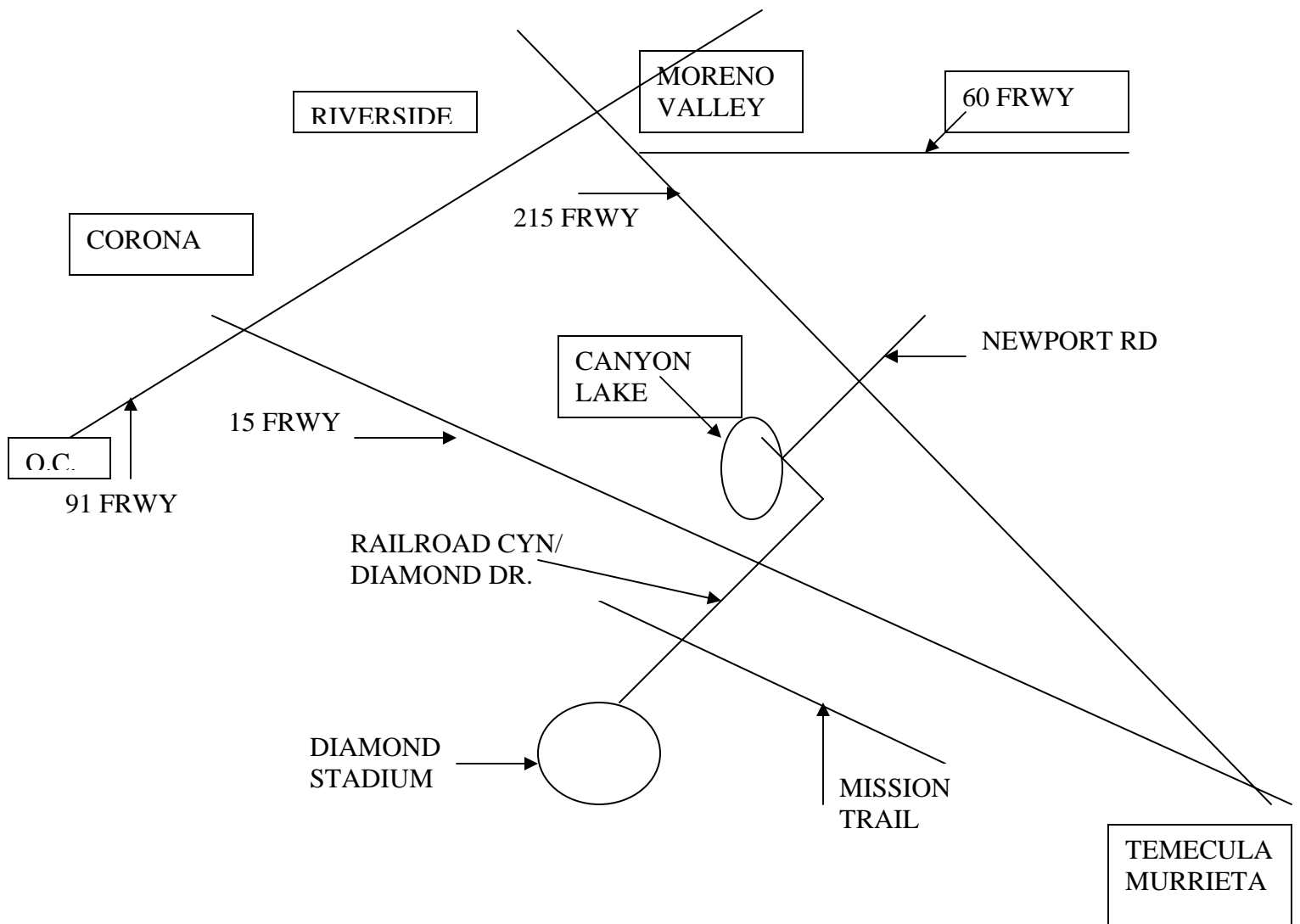
