STTAS: Prevention through detection and deterrence is the cornerstone of California's Homeland Security Strategy. Prevention has at its core cooperation sharing between agencies and across the full range of public safety disciplines. Our state prevention strategy (State Terrorist Threat Assessment System-STTAS) has four Regional Terrorism Threat Assessment Centers (RTTACs) collocated with the four FBI Field offices in California, minimizing reporting conflicts, providing statewide coverage and facilitating coordination with our Federal partners. The RTTACs maintain a regional threat assessment focus for their Area of Responsibility and directly connect to each other and the State Terrorism Assessment Center in Sacramento to collaborate on strategic products and situational awareness. Supporting the above efforts is the State Agency Terrorism Awareness Group (SATAG) that is comprised of State of California employees (many of whom are law enforcement officers) that enables suspicious activity reporting to the RTTACs concerning matters affecting state resources.
