ICS-300 Intermediate Incident Command System (ICS) and/or ICS-400 Advanced Incident Command System (ICS)

FEMA ICS-300: Intermediate ICS for Expanding Incidents for Operational First Responders. This is a **20-hour (2.5-day)** course geared toward individuals who may assume a supervisory role in an expanding or Type 3 incident.

Course Objectives:

- Describe how the NIMS Command and Management supports expanding incidents.
- Describe incident management and expanding incidents using the Incident Command System (ICS).
- Develop/Implement an Incident Action Plan on a simulated Type 3 incident.

FEMA ICS-400: Advanced ICS for Command and General Staff, Complex Incidents, and MACS. This is a **12-hour (1.5 day)** course geared toward senior personnel who are expected to perform in a management capacity at an incident.

- Describe an Area Command being established.
- Describe multi-agency coordination systems being established.
